CLASSICAL DECORATIVE ARTS recreated the reconstructed Trading Room wing for Driehaus Capital Management located in the historical CABLE HOUSE in Chicago,

IL. This recreation required 64 hand drawn stencil overlays and 33 individually mixed-to-match colors prepared on site to reproduce the room as Louis Sullivan originally intended. A ceiling mural with an additional transom window design was added but not before the unveiling of the stenciled walls in early 1996.



The CHICAGO THEATRE, build in 1921, provides a visual Beaux-Arts Revival fan-

tasy. In 2004, under new ownership, CLASSICAL became responsible for matching the existing original marble columns to the new wood concession stands. Panels were rendered realistically in a white veined faux marble. Matching became possible by closely observing



the magnificent marble usage throughout the building.
